

Artist in the Community Year End Report for 2010

The Artist in the Class Program, with funding from the CRD/PARC, was able to fund 14 artists who shared a total of 146 hours of their expertise at the elementary, middle and secondary schools on Salt Spring Island, including private and home school groups. There were workshops in the performing, literary and visual arts which included creative movement, mural painting, basic clay, lantern making, photography, drumming, journal writing, voice play and an exploration of oral traditions.

The Artist in the Community program, a pilot project of the school/center for the arts now has a very active committee who began planning workshops to be offered in the winter of 2011. More workshops are slated for the fall of 2011. Both of these will be written up in the 2011 year end report.
